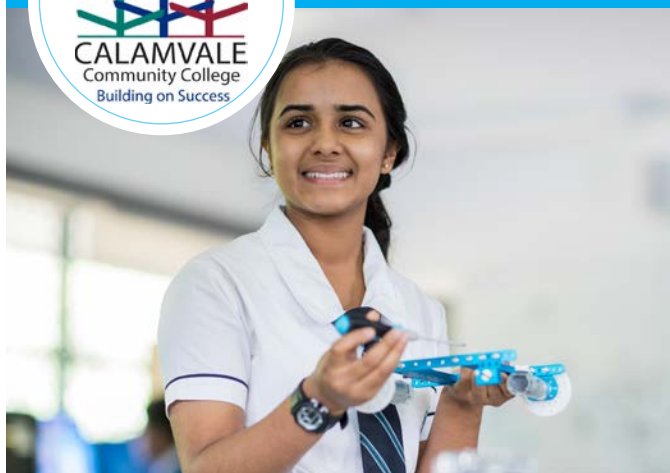
Our college is a thriving multicultural co-educational school for students from Prep to Year 12.
