

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dormitories: Students from grades 8 to 12 reside on campus. The school has two dormitory buildings. The current number of students living in the dorms is 32. Students from Vietnam, Morocco, Jamaica, Japan, Serbia, Mexico, France, Congo, Afghanistan, Dominica, South Korea, China, Germany, and Chile.

The girls' dormitory at Rivermont Collegiate was renovated in 2017, comprising five double rooms and two single rooms. The dormitory includes a living area, study spaces, an outdoor patio, and an art room with a pottery studio.

The boys' dormitory, completed in 2019, consists of 12 double rooms on the second floor, a laundry room, a common area for students, and on the first floor, a STEAM classroom equipped with a maker space and a maker store.
