

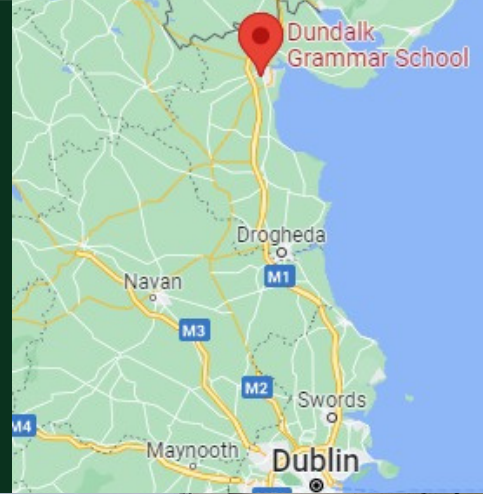

Overview

Common Areas:

- Shared Social Spaces: Comfortable common areas are available for all boarders to relax, socialize, and unwind.
- Study Support: Supervised evening study sessions and access to academic resources provide structured support for academic success.
- Dining: Daily communal meals are served in a welcoming environment, with dietary needs catered for.
- Laundry: Regular laundry service available to all boarders.

Modern, secure facilities with 24/7 supervision by dedicated houseparent's and pastoral staff.

Dormitories

Adjacent to the school, the Victorian-style boarding house hosts the dormitories for the boarding community. Students share living areas and bathroom facilities, with an emphasis placed on keeping their personal areas tidy. 6th Year students have access to a common room and kitchen facilities, providing opportunities to develop valuable life skills.
