

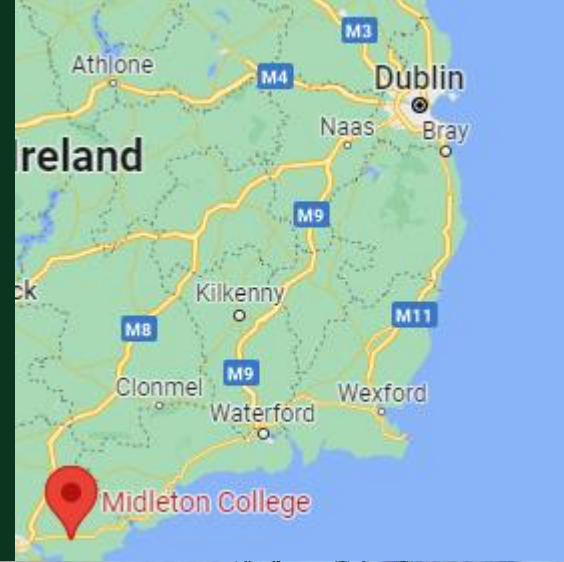

Midleton is a town in south-eastern County Cork, Ireland. It lies approximately 16 km east of Cork City on the Owenacurra River and the N25 road, which connects Cork to the port of Rosslare. A satellite town of Cork City, Midleton is part of Metropolitan Cork. It is the central hub of business for the East Cork Area. Midleton is within the Cork East Dáil constituency.

## Sports, Arts & Leisure Facilities

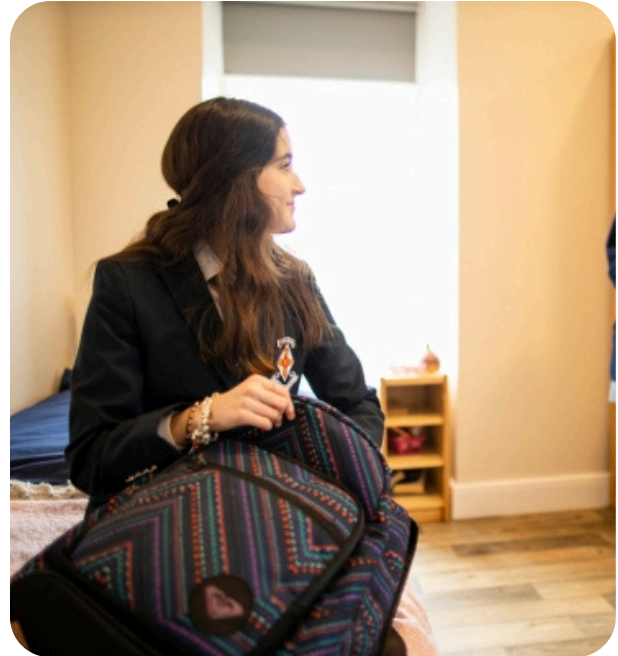

## Overview

**Common Rooms:** Equipped with TVs, games, sofas, and kitchenettes for snacks.

**Activities Room:** Includes table tennis, board games, and space for evening events (movie nights, quizzes, etc.).

**Study Rooms:** Quiet areas with desks and Wi-Fi for homework and exam preparation.

**Dining Hall:** Communal meals served daily, with dietary needs accommodated.

**Laundry Facilities:** Available for student use (seniors may manage their own laundry).

**Outdoor Spaces:** Access to sports fields, basketball courts, and green areas.

## Dormitories

Dormitory sizes range from 4 students to larger dormitories of 12.

**Bedrooms:** Junior Students (1st-3rd Year): Typically share dormitory-style rooms (2-4 students per room), with personal storage spaces and study desks.

**Senior Students (4th-6th Year):** Often have smaller shared rooms or individual study bedrooms.
