

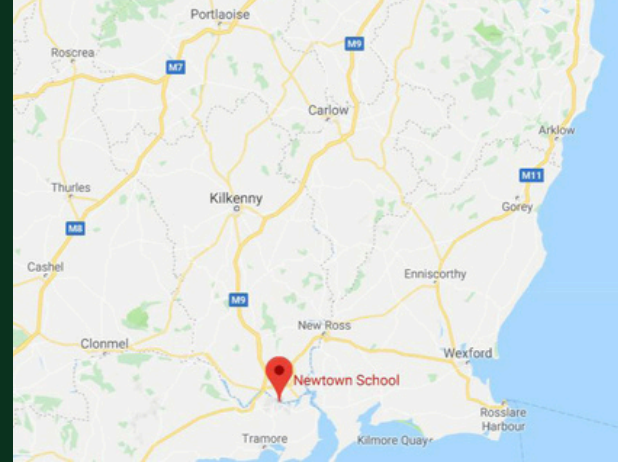

Overview

Boarding Houses: Separate accommodations for boys and girls with shared common areas for socializing and relaxation.

Study Support: Supervised evening study sessions and provided access to academic resources.

Recreational Spaces: Use of the school's sports facilities (e.g., hockey pitches, tennis courts) and arts studios.

24/7 supervision by houseparent's and pastoral staff.

Weekend activities: Cultural trips, outdoor pursuits (e.g., hiking, kayaking), and team-building events.

Dormitories

Boarding students will be allocated to a dorm depending on the year they are joining.

Dormitory sizes range from 4 to 6 students dormitories. All dorms are laid out in a way that all year groups will be grouped together to gain the maximum potential out of boarding life.
