

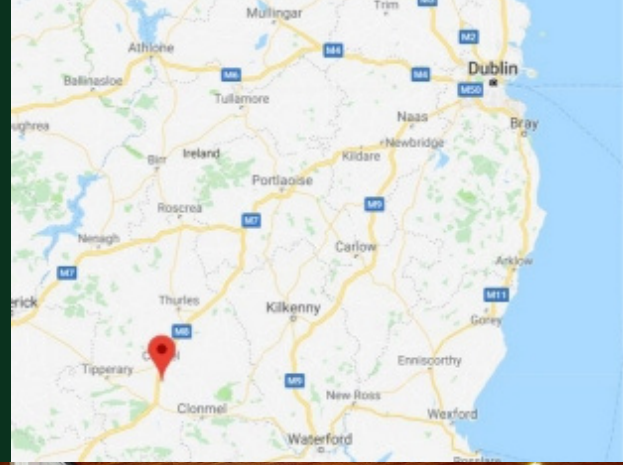

Overview

Modern Boarding Houses: Students live in age-appropriate accommodations with separate areas for juniors and seniors.

Common Rooms: Social spaces for relaxation, games, and group activities.

Study Support: Supervised evening study sessions and provided access to academic resources.

Recreational Facilities: Use of the school's sports fields, gym, and outdoor spaces.

Weekend programs: Trips, cultural events, and team sports (e.g., rugby, hockey).

24/7 supervision by houseparents and pastoral staff.

Dormitories

1st & 2nd Year: Boys in dorms with 4 beds, arranged in single units. Meanwhile, girls share twin rooms.

3rd Year: Boys share twin and triple rooms, while girls share twin rooms.

4th & 5th Year: Boys share either twin rooms or single rooms. Girls continue in their close-knit twin room arrangement.

6th Year: Boys are in a single room. Girls, meanwhile, enjoy twin rooms.
