

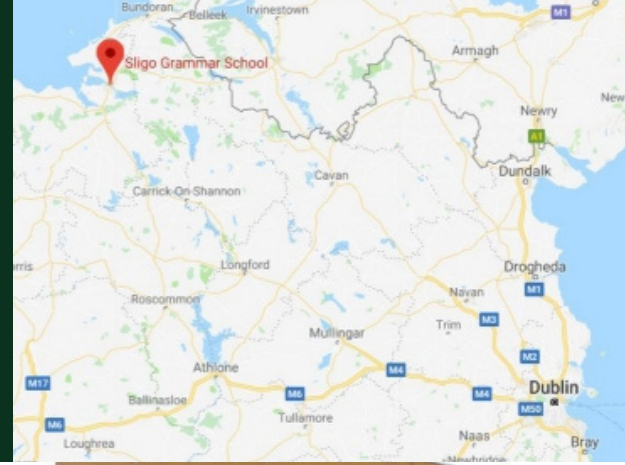

Overview

Boarding Houses: Separate accommodations for boys and girls with shared social spaces.

Study Areas: Supervised evening study sessions and provided access to academic resources.

Recreational Facilities: Use of the school's sports fields, gym, and arts facilities.

24/7 supervision by houseparents and qualified staff.

Dormitories

Boys: The Boys' Boarding House has 5 dorms, a common room with a TV, pool tables, and table tennis. The refurbishment included renovation of dorms, a new shower room, a new TV room, and a glass corridor to their Prep room. Sixth years have their common room and kitchen.

Girls: There are four dorms, which are arranged by year groups and split up into cubicles. Two-year groups usually share, and each dorm has an assigned cubicle.
